Ford's F-350 Super Duty - A Pickup Truck That Democratizes Towing

For the heavy towing enthusiast who enjoys the luxury RV lifestyle, whose passion it is to use a truck to tow a heavy-duty travel trailer or fifth-wheel, new meaning has been added to the words Built Ford Tough.

It is often the case with auto manufacturers that a “new” model means last year’s model is “carried over” with a few new cosmetic changes that meet the definition of “new” vehicle. However, this

is not (I REPEAT, NOT) the case with the 2020 Ford Super Duty heavy duty truck. The folks at Ford cut no corners in delivering their most capable and most powerful Super Duty ever.

With tough and powerful design enhancements to the sheet metal and new options for added capability, productivity, performance and safety, the new 2020 Ford Super Duty is a beast to put it simply.

With Super Duty coming in F-250, F-350 and F-450 configurations, the flip of a coin found RV America reviewing the Super Duty F-350.

Overall, model year 2020 finds Ford introducing an all-new 7.3L V8 gasoline engine for the Super Duty. The new gas engine produces best-in-class gas horsepower of 430 and best-in-class gas torque of 475 ft.-lbs. The other two engines offered in the Super Duty lineup are the standard 6.2L V8 gasoline engine





that produces 385 horses and 430 lb.-ft. torque and is capable of best-in-class maximum payload capacity of 7,850 pounds. If gas isn't your thing, Ford also offers the famed 6.7L Power Stroke diesel. Yielding 440 hp and 1,050 lb ft. torque, the Power Stroke Diesel is one of the truly superb engines in the market when it comes to towing heavy loads, with a best-in-class max conventional towing capacity of 24,200 pounds, best-in-class max gooseneck towing of 37,000 pounds and best-in-class max fifth-wheel towing of 32,500 pounds.

RV America elected to review an F-350 Super Duty equipped with Ford's flagship Power Stroke Diesel and configured as a dual-rear-wheel 4x2. As configured, this truck is capable of towing up to 22,000 lbs (GVW) with a conventional travel trailer. When linked to a gooseneck trailer, it

can tow 36,000 lbs. (REPEAT 36,000 LBS GVW). With Ford's factory installed Integrated Trailer Brake Controller, this turbo charged diesel F-350 makes for a towing ride when adventures take the RV towing enthusiast through places with hilly terrain like the Rocky Mountains in the West.

New for all 2020 Super Duty pickup trucks is the introduction of a TorqShift® 10-speed Automatic Transmission (7 forward gears and 3 overdrive gears) with selectable drive modes: Normal, Tow/Haul, Eco & Deep sand/snow. Using state-of-the-art computer chip technology, even when towing steep grades such as those in the Rockies, it is totally transparent to the operator that this transmission seamlessly shifts to the proper gear to match changes as elevation

grades increase and decrease (that's huge). This transmission takes the pleasure-of-towing a conventional or 5th-wheel RV to new levels not seen before.

The title of this review includes the word "democratize" and that is because of Ford's driver-assist features that are available on Super Duty that makes life while towing 'worlds easier'. The new Pro Trailer Backup Assist feature makes it possible for those who have never backed up a vehicle with a towable attached, to now do so and do it with ease and success. When engaged this system allows the driver to turn a knob found on the dash to steer the vehicle and trailer as it backs up – all without the driver ever touching the steering wheel. That gets combined with Ford's new Ultimate Trailer Tow Camera System and the Trailer Reverse Guidance feature, which uses

multiple cameras to display the trailer's angle and direction on the truck's infotainment screen and it provides steering suggestions to most efficiently direct the trailer backwards. Should a turn to the left or the right be required because it may not be possible to begin backing the truck and towable in a straight line, the knob is operated by the driver's fingers making the necessary adjustments. Both systems are built to work with all trailer styles – including fifth-wheel and gooseneck. This is amazing stuff!

Safety features available on the 2020 Super Duty include a trailer blind spot detection system called Blind Spot Information System, or BLIS, with Trailer Coverage. There is also a system that notifies the driver if they are wandering or drifting out of their lane called Audible Lane-Departure Warning, which can help combat accidents

caused by driver fatigue from long hours behind the wheel. There is also Pre-Collision Assist with Automatic Emergency Braking, which helps you avoid or mitigate a crash in the unfortunate case one was to happen. The best part is that these advanced safety features come standard on the XLT trim level and above – well more than 50 percent of the lineup. Again, this is really good Stuff.

Driver and passenger comfort is well attended to with contoured cockpit seats that are both heated and cooled on certain trim levels. These seats provide a massage feature that prevents driver's legs from going numb and revitalizes the occupant should travel weariness set in. A new larger windshield yields additional natural light inside

the cab, while available heated windshield wipers help remove ice that has accumulated when parked during a winter storm. This reduces the amount of scraping of the windshield that may be required to get back on the road. Depending upon the bed length of the Super Duty, the fuel tank can be ordered as 26-gallon, 36-gallon or 48-gallon tanks. With the largest fuel tank option, the operating range potentially can be near the 1,000-mile mark, a more than respectable driving range between fuel stops.

For those who enjoy towing a conventional travel trailer, the Super Duty now offers a stowable ramp system that facilitates the RV enthusiast bringing along a golf cart or ATV in the bed of the truck. When not in use these ramps are kept conveniently stowed above the wheel wells in the bed of the truck. Ford seems to have



thought of everything including the requirements of those who enjoy primitive wilderness RV camping. With much of our nation laced with National Forest; State and County Parks, and with wide swaths of BLM land across the West that can be taken advantage of, the Super Duty also offers a new off-road package called TREMOR Off-Road Package. This provides rear axle lockers, a raised platform for clearance, skid plates, and 35-inch-diameter Goodyear Wrangler Duratrac maximum-traction tires mounted on 18-inch matte black wheels. Progressive-rate springs balance heavy-duty towing performance needs while also controlling body motion on rutted, rock-strewn trails.

The Ford F-350 Super duty is a Class III Truck which is defined by DOT as A truck with a GVWR of 10,001 – 14,000 pounds. For additional information about

Hawaiian Banana Nut Bread

A scrumptious tropical spin on banana nut bread is super simple and melts-in-your mouth good! So moist, yummy and perfect every time that everyone will love.

Ingredients:

- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- ¾ teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 cup chopped pecans or walnuts
- 3 eggs, beaten
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 2 cups mashed very ripe bananas
- 1 (8 ounce) can crushed pineapple, drained
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 cup flaked coconut
- 1 cup maraschino cherries, diced



Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Grease two 9x5 loaf pans
2. In large mixing bowl, combine the flour, salt, baking soda, sugar and cinnamon. Add the nuts, eggs, oil banana, pineapple, vanilla, coconut and cherries; stir just until blended. Pour batter evenly into the prepared pans.
3. Baked for 60 minutes, or until a tooth pick inserted into the center of a loaf comes out clean. Cool in the pan 10 minutes, then removed to a wire rack to cool.
4. Get a slice of bread and head to the porch to enjoy!
